



Puffins: Spring 1

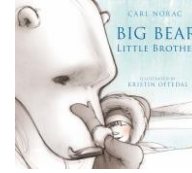
January 3rd – February 10th



English

Maths

In maths year 1s will be exploring Number and place value and addition and subtractions. Year 2s will look at addition and subtraction, money and multiplication and division.

Year 1-

- Place value of number to 20
- Partitioning numbers into tens and ones
- Number bonds to 20
- Doubling
- Counting on from a number
- Subtraction by counting backwards

Year 2 -

- Adding and subtracting across 10
- Subtracting two digit numbers
- Counting money
- Finding the same amount of money
- Finding change
- Making equal groups by sharing and grouping
- 2, 5 and 10 times tables
- Dividing by 2, 5 and 10
