## Animals



### Maths

In our maths lessons this term, Robins Class will be focusing on numbers to and beyond twenty. We will then move onto working on number bonds to five, ten and twenty. Following this, we will work on recapping 2D and 3D shapes, building on our learning from earlier in the year. We will finish the year with a learning unit on addition and subtraction, focusing in particular on recording in our maths lessons.

### English

Robins Class will focus on the books below in our English lessons this term, using these to support our learning on animals and dinosaurs. Robins Class will focus on successfully and independently writing sentences that can be read by ourselves and others, ensuring that we include a capital letter at the beginning, full stop at the end and finger spaces between our words. Robins Class will work on writing two or more sentences together, that all link to a particular theme or topic.

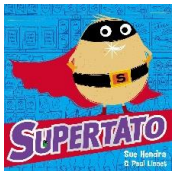
- Little Wandle reading books are sent home on a Thursday (after the third reading session of the week).

We will continue to write in your child's reading record when we read at school, **please do write in your child's reading record when you read with them at home too.**

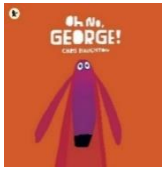
#### Homework

- Homework sheets will be sent home on a Friday, we will check for completed sheets throughout the week, there is no particular day that these need to be completed by.

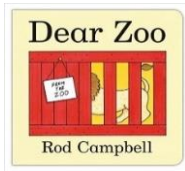

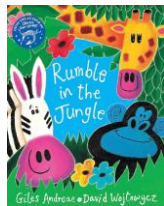

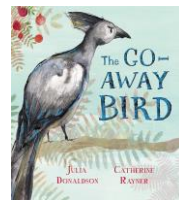

## Phonics



This term, Robins Class will be focussing on words with long vowel sounds and words with adjacent consonants. We will also focus on words ending in -s /s/ -s /z/ and -es. We will then move onto focusing on longer words and words ending in -ing, -ed /t/, ed /id/ /ed/ and -ed /d/.

Robins Class will continue to work more independently within phonics lessons and will be encouraged to use their own phonics knowledge and resources in the classroom to read and write independently out of phonics time as well.



## Understanding the World

Robins Class will continue our focus on the seasons of the year and the changes that can be seen and felt around our school now that we are in the season of summer.

We will spend this term learning about animals, birds and dinosaurs, using our focus books and our trip to Cholderton Rare Breeds Farm to support this learning.



## Communication and Language

This term, Robins Class will be learning vocabulary based on our themes of summer, animals and dinosaurs.



## Expressive arts and design

This term, we'll be working on using a variety of techniques and resources that we've learnt and used throughout the school year so far to create some wonderful animal, dinosaur and summer artwork. We'll also focus on artwork outside.

In music lessons this term, Robins Class will focus on creative composing and the use of dimensions. Robins will also learn about graphic notation.



## Physical Development

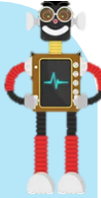
In our PE lessons this term, Robins Class will be focusing on athletics, linking with the Olympics. We'll also be getting ourselves prepared for our first sports day at school!
