- Welcome our children and their parents or carers to the Wherwell 'family' and ensure that our ethos of 'children first' underpins all we do

Wherwell School will:

- Teach a broad and balanced curriculum which meets the needs of pupils and the requirements of the National Curriculum and Early Years Foundation Stage
- Welcome the parent/carer into the life of the school and keep them informed of the learning that is planned for their child
- Provide a safe and secure environment for all children and take all reasonable steps to deal with a child's concerns
- Let parents/carers know about any concerns or problems that affect their child's work or behaviour, attendance or punctuality
- Provide equal opportunities for all pupils, with regard to individual needs
- Keep parents/carers fully informed about their child's educational development, through written reports, parent/carer appointments and contact with teaching staff as required
- Communicate school events and activities designed to enrich the curriculum through newsletters, the school website and messaging where appropriate

Pupils - I will:

- Try to arrive on time with the right equipment and in school uniform
- Respect the school environment, keeping it tidy and free from damage and using resources respectfully and carefully
- Treat all school adults, children and visitors with respect, and be polite and caring to others
- Work hard in all lessons
- Follow the school values and meet expected behaviour standards in school, on visits and during sporting events, taking responsibility for my own behaviour
- Follow the rules for Computing
- Talk to an adult in school if I am unhappy and trust that they will help
- Talk about my learning at home, engage with homework and return it to school on time
- Parents & Carers I/we will:
- Ensure that my child attends school unless there is a good reason (e.g. ill health that may affect their learning or that of others)
- Ensure that my child arrives properly equipped, wearing school uniform and on time
- Let the school know, by 8.45am, if my child is unable to attend school and collect my child promptly at 3.05pm
- Support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour and be respectful toward others
- Support my child with home activities, including reading, homework and other opportunities for home learning
- Attend Parent's Evenings and discussions about my child's progress at school
- Let the school know of any concerns or problems that may affect my child's learning, behaviour or willingness to attend
- Talk to my child about their life at school and support them in following their part of the home/school agreement
- Safeguard my children on the internet e.g. ensuring age appropriate games and content
- Only take photographs of MY child for personal use and will not place any photographs taken on school premises on social media
