
June 6th- July 21st



English

We will begin our final term with the book *slow down* by Rachel Williams. We will use this beautifully illustrated book to write a recount as one of the animals from the book.

Our final book will be *Rapunzel* by Bethan Wollvin. We will be using this book to write a character description of Rapunzel and then we will re-writing our own version of the fairy-tale.



Maths

This term in maths we will be covering the topics of time, money, position, direction and statistics.

Year 1-

- Telling the time to an hour and half and hour.
- Sequencing events in time order
- Knowing the value of coins and notes.
- Describing movements and positions.
- Collecting data
- Using a tally chart.

Year 2 –

- Telling the time to hour, half, quarter past and quarter to.
- Adding and problem solving with money.
- Describing movements, positions and turns with shapes and objects.
- Making a tally chart
- Collecting and interpreting data.
