


Kingfishers: Autumn 1

English


Maths

Year 2 We will:

- count in steps of 2, 3, and 5 from 0, and in tens from any number, forward and backward
- recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number (tens, ones) and read / write numbers to at least 100 in numerals and in words
- identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations, including the number line
- compare and order numbers from 0 up to 100; use and = signs
- use place value and number facts to solve problems.

Year 3 We will:

- count from 0 in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100; find 10 or 100 more or less than a given number
- recognise the place value of each digit in a three-digit number (hundreds, tens, ones) and read/write numbers up to 1000 in numerals and in words
- compare and order numbers up to 1000
- identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations
- solve number problems and practical problems involving these ideas

PSHE

We will be studying 'Get Heartsmart' on HeartSmart which is all about recognising that choices can have good and not so good consequences and recognising that their behaviour can affect other people.

Computing

We will be learning about IT all around us. We will discuss how IT benefits society in places such as libraries and hospitals. Whilst discussing the responsible use of technology, we will think about how to make smart choices when using it.

MFL

We will be learning how to greet people as well as introduce ourselves and discuss key information about ourselves.

History

We will be learning about the Stone age through to the iron age, studying how life changed during that period of time and key events. Keep your eyes peeled for a trip!

Science

In science, we will be learning about forces, particularly how things are pushed or pulled. For our longitudinal study, we will be investigating how a shadow changes over a day and through the year.

RE

We are learning to investigate what happens during the festival of Divali and whether the celebrations bring a sense of belonging to Hindus.

Music

Stonehenge and Mystical Sounds.
We will be working on beat, rhythm, timbre and texture. We will be exploring sounds with different timbres and creating patterns.

Homework:

- Fortnightly spelling words to practice at home, tested weekly.
- Reading for a minimum of 5 minutes per night, 5 times per week, recorded in reading records.
- Maths/English alternating weekly.
- Home learning task half termly.
