


# Kingfishers: Summer 2

6<sup>th</sup> June – 21<sup>st</sup> July

## English

We will be using the story 'Tell me a Dragon' to write an information text about dragons, using adjectives and exciting vocabulary to describe our dragons. We will be focussing on spelling common exception words.



Next, we will be using 'The Great Kapok Tree' to write persuasive texts involving the rainforest, thinking about selecting a viewpoint and how to convince a reader.

## Maths

### Year 2

- interpret and construct simple pictograms, tally charts, block diagrams and simple tables
- ask and answer simple questions by counting the number of objects in each category and sorting the categories by quantity
- ask and answer questions about totalling and comparing categorical data.
- choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure length/height in any direction (m/cm); mass (kg/g); temperature (°C); capacity (litres/ml) to the nearest appropriate unit, using rulers, scales, thermometers and measuring vessels

### Year 3

- interpret and present data using bar charts, pictograms and tables
- solve one-step and two-step questions [for example, 'How many more?' and 'How many fewer?'] using information presented in scaled bar charts and pictograms and tables.
- measure, compare, add and subtract: lengths (m/cm/mm); mass (kg/g); volume/capacity (l/ml)
