


Kingfishers: Summer 1


17th April – 26th May

English

We will be continuing our learning journey on 'The Bear and the Piano', but using a couple of new focuses in our writing such as a narrative and persuasive writing.



Next, we will be studying the book 'The Snail and the Whale'. We will use it to support us in writing letters.



Maths

Year 2

- compare and sequence intervals of time
- tell and write the time to five minutes, including quarter past/to the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times
- know the number of minutes in an hour and the number of hours in a day

Year 3

- tell and write the time from an analogue clock, including using Roman numerals from I to XII, and 12-hour and 24-hour clocks
- estimate and read time with increasing accuracy to the nearest minute; record and compare time in terms of seconds, minutes and hours; use vocabulary such as o'clock, a.m./p.m., morning, afternoon, noon and midnight
- know the number of seconds in a minute and the number of days in each month, year and leap year
- compare durations of events [for example to calculate the time taken by particular events or tasks].
