



Kingfishers: Spring 2

20th February – 31st March

English

Our next learning journey will focus on poetry, using the collection of poetry 'Werewolf Club Rules'. We will also use it as inspiration to recap some other styles of writing that we have previously covered such as narratives.



Next, we will move on to *The Bear and the Piano*, which we will use to learn about persuasive writing, writing adverts to advertise for the bear.

Maths

Year 2

- recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables, including recognising odd and even numbers
- solve problems involving multiplication and division, using materials, arrays, repeated addition, mental methods, and multiplication and division facts, including problems in contexts
- identify and describe the properties of 2-D shapes, including the number of sides and line symmetry in a vertical line \square and identify and describe the properties of 3-D shapes, including the number of edges, vertices and faces

Year 3

- write and calculate mathematical statements for multiplication and division using the multiplication tables that they know, including for two-digit numbers times one-digit numbers, using mental and progressing to formal written methods
- recognise angles as a property of shape or a description of a turn
- identify horizontal and vertical lines and pairs of perpendicular and parallel lines.

MFL

This term we will explore different animals, including humans, investigating the question 'Why do we have a skeleton?'
