


Sparrowhawks: Summer 2

English

We now migrate into the gorgeous book *We Travel So Far* by Laura Knowles. Our writing focus will be to create a class book of animal migration journeys. We will hone our non-fiction retrieval skills and develop our vocabulary to present our own writing in the style of the book.



Our last book for the year is the stunning *Town Is by the Sea*, by Joanna Schwartz, set in a rural mining town. We delve deep into discussions about whether children should follow in their parent's footsteps or forge their own path, creating diary entries to reflect their end thinking.

Maths

Y4 – **Times Table Check week of June 5th – June 16th**

Geometry – Properties of shapes: Compare and classify geometric shapes (triangles and quadrilaterals), identifying symmetry presented in different orientations.

Geometry – Position and Direction: Describe positions as coordinates, describe movements between positions as translation and plot specified points, drawing sides to complete a given polygon.

Consolidate learning: Place Value, Fractions and Measurement

Y3 – Measurement: Measure, compare, add and subtract: lengths (m/cm/mm); mass (kg/g); volume and capacity (l/ml)

Consolidate learning in key strands: Number, Fractions and Geometry
