


# Sparrowhawks: Summer 1


April 17<sup>th</sup> - May 26<sup>th</sup>

## English

## Maths

Y4 – Place Value – Review key learning; explore Roman Numerals

- Geometry – compare and classify quadrilaterals and triangles; identify different angles and lines of symmetry within 2D shapes
- Measurement – read, write and convert 12 & 24 hour clock using both analogue and digital clocks
- Multiplication – prepare for the Times Table Check in June.

Y3 – Geometry – identify and draw 2D shapes; recognise and model 3D shapes; recognise right angles and their turns; identify horizontal and vertical lines as well as perpendicular and parallel lines.

- Measurement – Tell and read an analogue clock; 12 & 24 hour clock; estimate and read time to the nearest minute; use time vocabulary (am/pm, o'clock, midnight, etc)
- Place Value – Review key learning; explore Roman Numerals
