ROBINS

Robins have been creating some wonderful artwork based on the book Puffin Peter. We started by watching a video clip of the illustrator (who is also the author) creating a picture of Puffin Peter. We then gathered the resources that we needed (pencils, crayons, paint and watercolours) and followed step by step instructions to create our own Puffins. Finally, we used water colour paints to create a background picture of the sea or Puffin Peter's rocky island and we stuck our puffins onto our backgrounds. PUFFINS

Puffins have started to look at the book 'Float' by Daniel Miyares which is a wordless picture book. In the story the boy makes a paper boat which everyone in Puffins has had a go at making, it was quite tricky and a lot of folding was involved! We have used that activity to help us write instructions about how to make the boat and we shared what we learnt with Parents at our Learning Outcome on Thursday.

We have also been busy learning how to sew using a simple running stitch in DT whilst making our hats.







KINGFISHERS

Kingfishers had a lovely time at Winchester Science Centre on Tuesday. They started with a workshop in which they learnt about the James Webb Telescope. They learnt which materials would keep the telescope cool by learning about infrared light. They saw how light gets diffracted through special glasses. Kingfishers particularly enjoyed the Planetarium show where they learnt all about our solar system as well as some of the stars and constellations we can see from Earth.



SPARROWHAWKS

Sparrowhawks have been very busy with our Egyptian-themed work. In English, we have created a fact file about an Egyptian artefact. We were also very lucky to have The Drama Hut come and do an Egyptian workshop with the children where they created different freeze frames of Egyptian gods. Finally, Sparrowhawks have made clay sarcophaguses and toy mummies to go in them.





HOUSE MARTINS

It's been a busy end to the half-term in House Martins! The children thoroughly enjoyed their ancient Greeks drama workshop last week. We created some brilliant scenes demonstrating our knowledge of several aspects of ancient Greece. This week, the children have been making and painting ancient Greek inspired pottery with Mrs Hill.
