1) Quality of Education

Raise attainment and progress in Writing across the school, particularly for Pupil Premium, with a focus on improving stamina, vocabulary, spelling, and sentence structure.

To ensure a smooth and effective transition from Year R to Year 1 which supports pupils' emotional wellbeing, sustains progress in early learning, and prepares them for the increased expectations of the Year 1 curriculum.

To ensure the effective use of adaptive teaching strategies to support SEND and disadvantaged pupils.

To increase the percentage of pupils achieving Greater Depth in Writing and Maths across all year groups by implementing high-quality teaching strategies and targeted interventions.
