

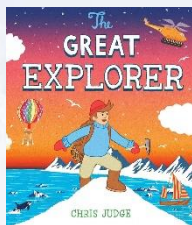
Kingfishers: Autumn 2 – Frozen Worlds

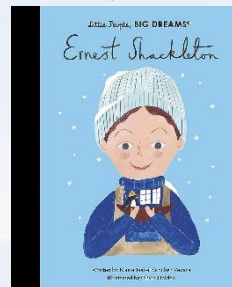
English

R.E.
