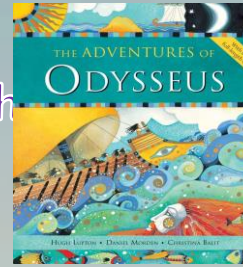

## English

We will be reading Greek Myths this term. We will be comparing our key text, *The Adventures of Odysseus*, to other Greek myths with a view to writing our own Greek Myths.

**NB:** children are awarded House Points for reading at least 3 times a week, including at least once to an adult. This must be recorded in their Reading Record.
