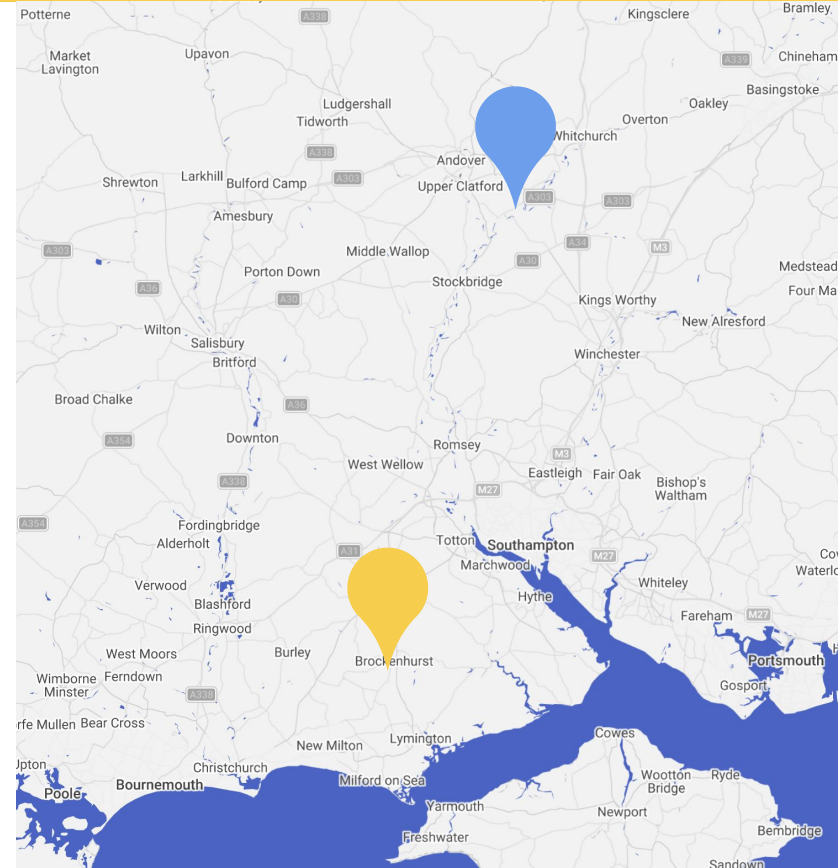


LOCATION



Tile Barn is located in the heart of the New Forest, approximately one hour from us, making it an easily accessible countryside location.

Travel will be arranged by private coach, with transport provided both to and from the venue. This ensures everyone can travel together comfortably and arrive on time, without the need to organise individual lifts or parking.



WHY HAVE WE CHOSEN



TILE BARN?

We have chosen Tile Barn Outdoor Centre based on the positive reviews for food and the size of the site. It is a modern venue but still offers more of a camping-style residential experience, which aligns well with spending time outdoors in the New Forest National Park

FACILITIES



We have booked the camping pods, which are eco-friendly, solar-powered pods that can sleep up to four people, offering a comfortable and modern alternative to traditional camping.

The pods also have access to separate gendered bathroom and showering facilities located nearby for convenience.

All activities are on site, meaning children remain in familiar surroundings while still enjoying a varied and engaging residential experience. The pods themselves are designed to blend sustainability with practicality, providing a safe and enjoyable base for the trip.

We will be staying in the Poppy pods, which are small huts featuring a convertible bed and two camping-style cots. The rear bed includes a table that folds down to create two sleeping spaces.

Please note that bedding is **not** provided.

Space inside the pods is limited, so we ask that you pack thoughtfully and only bring essentials. There are eco toilets within our enclosure, but children should bring a torch if they need to use the facilities during the night.
