












FIRST EVER TEXT WAS SENT IN 1992



- Founded in 2010
- Bought by Facebook in 2012 for 1 billion dollars
- Filters for photos
- Upload picture straight to social network sites
- Mobile phone generation
- Privacy settings are key



TIK TOK

- Fairly new app (launched 2017)
- Upload video straight to social network sites
- Lip sync, comedy and talent videos
- Problem with content, songs, adverts



WHATS APP

- All based around phone number
- Group chats can get out of hand
- Videos can be seen, pop up etc
- All messages are encrypted



- Created in 2005 18+ (13 with parent permission)
- There are currently around 1 billion regular users
- Despacito (Bieber) now has 6.6 BILLION views!
- 400 tweets per minute containing a youtube link
- No real restrictions but there's a Kids Youtube Site
- Anyone can get an account!





- Your tone of voice cannot be heard ("why did you write that")
- You feel able to say things or send things that you may not say to their face
- It's easy to get sucked into conversations, comments and photos
- It's really easy for people to find out about you information, schools, family
- It actually creates 'fake friends'
- It's often a place for nasty banter (example)

WHAT TO DO IN THE EVENT OF A BANTER ESCALATION SCENARIO









A strip club shows women naked. They push their breasts toward the camera, and players can direct their hands to touch the strippers' bodies when bouncers aren't looking. Prostitutes attempt to sell themselves on the street, and many of the game's female characters are clad in revealing clothing. Men and women are shown having sex, though they aren't naked. Some scenes imply masturbation, oral sex, and even sex with a corpse, including pleasured moaning sounds. Men's genitals are shown, though in non-sexual context.



Highly addictive and can access other players online. Can never be entirely sure who you are playing. Although seemingly harmless it can be quite violent and involves zombies, monsters and blood




