English

Maths

In Maths this term, year 4 will be learning about time and statistics. Year 5 will learn to convert measurements and measure capacity

Year 4

- Interpret and draw charts
- Converting to and from the 24 hour clock
- Cover between digital and analogue time
- Covert between years, weeks and days

Year 5

- Converting units: mm, ml, kg and km
- Convert units of time
- Converting imperial and metric units
- To use cubic centimetres
- Estimate volume and capacity
